The Jerusalem Princess Basma Centre (JPBC), located on Jerusalem's Mount of Olives, works for the integration and empowerment of children with disabilities and their families. Through its Child Rehabilitation Centre, JPBC delivers treatment and rehabilitation services to Palestinian children aged 0-15 with disabilities from the West Bank, Gaza Strip, and Jerusalem. Additionally, the center serves as a National Resource Centre, facilitating capacity building, clinical training, and the dissemination of knowledge and best practices.
