Your Generosity in Action: Spotlight on the Jerusalem Princess Basma Centre



Perched on the Mount of Olives, the Jerusalem Princess Basma Centre (JPBC) is a sanctuary of hope and healing for children with disabilities and their families. As one of the Episcopal Diocese of Jerusalem's flagship institutions, JPBC is dedicated to delivering holistic, family-centered care, from therapy and education to outreach and advocacy.

Reaching Beyond Boundaries

JPBC's mission extends far beyond its main campus in East Jerusalem. Through its robust outreach programs, the centre ensures that children in remote, underserved, and underresourced areas of the West Bank and Gaza receive the life-changing care they need.

In the West Bank, JPBC collaborates with local clinics to conduct regular outreach visits, bringing therapy, medical assessments, and caregiver training to families who cannot easily access care. In 2024, these visits touched the lives of 1,460 children, breaking down barriers of geography and access.

In Gaza, JPBC operates a satellite rehabilitation unit at Al Ahli Arab Hospital, where children receive critical therapy. In 2024 alone, this program provided over 4,000 therapy sessions, offering a lifeline to children and families in desperate need of support.

In 2024, JPBC's achievements reflect the power of your generosity and the centre's commitment to excellence:


- 510 children with disabilities received tailored therapy and support at JPBC's main facility in East Jerusalem.
- 415 children in Gaza either recovering from injuries sustained during the conflict or with chronic disabilities accessed life-saving care at JPBC's satellite unit at Ahli Hospital.
- 225 children living in displaced areas throughout Gaza, including temporary shelters and tents, have benefited from vital therapy sessions.

A Story of Hope: Sila's Journey

Born with a congenital heart defect and motor delays, Sila faced overwhelming challenges from the start. By ten months, she weighed just six pounds and struggled with basic motor skills. Her family turned to JPBC for help.

Through intensive therapy, Sila began making remarkable progress. Today, at age three, she is taking her first assisted steps, holding a pen to color, and engaging more actively with her family. Her mother shares, "Now that Sila can stand and walk with support, I dream of the day she will walk independently. I am building my hopes with each small step forward."
